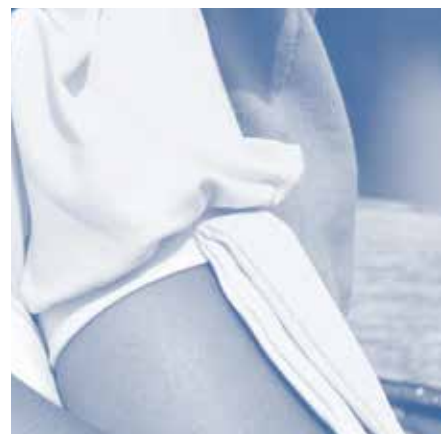

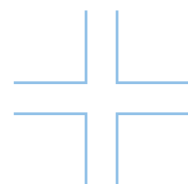
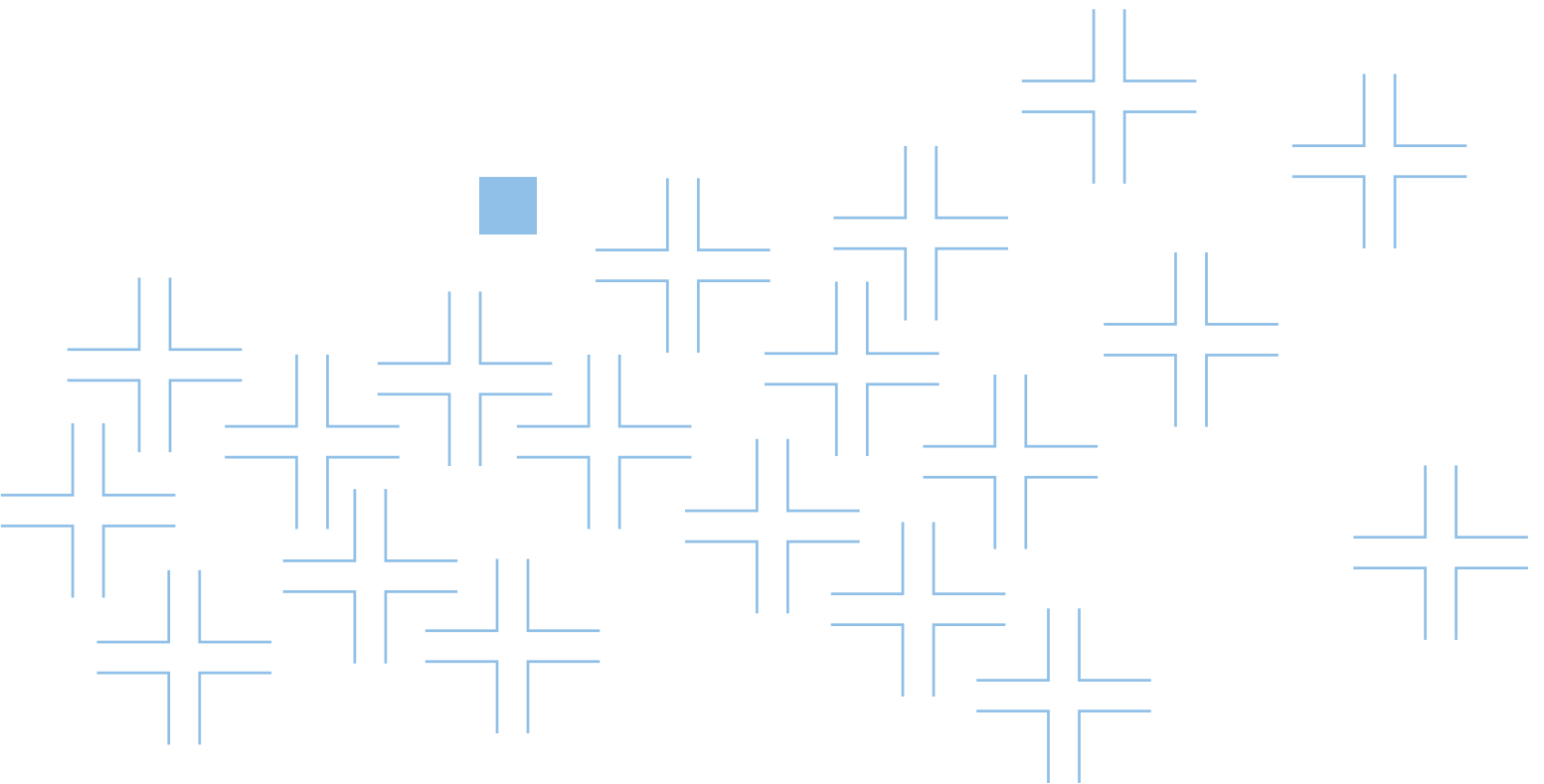


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The mission of the St. Maarten Medical Center is:

St. Maarten Medical Center (SMMC) is an ambitious and growing hospital organization on St Maarten. With more than 300 employees, 25 specialists and a capacity of 69 beds, we continuously strive to ensure safe, quality health care.

Our primary service area is St. Maarten, St. Eustatius and Saba which represents a total population of approximately 60.000 people, constituting a multi-cultural mix with more than 100 different nationalities. In addition, we offer health care services to the 2 million annual visiting tourists.

SMMC is preparing to start construction of a state-of-the-art new hospital, the St. Maarten General Hospital, with the aim to expand its services and offer 'Quality Care Close To Home' in order to accommodate the increased care demand of the people of St. Maarten, its visitors and neighboring islands.

Quality & Safety

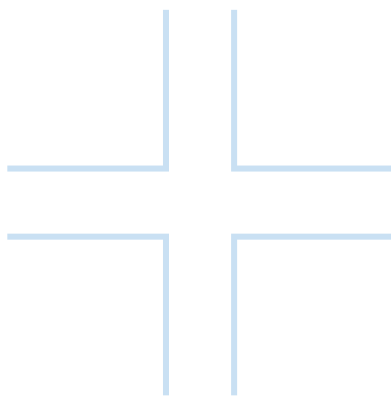

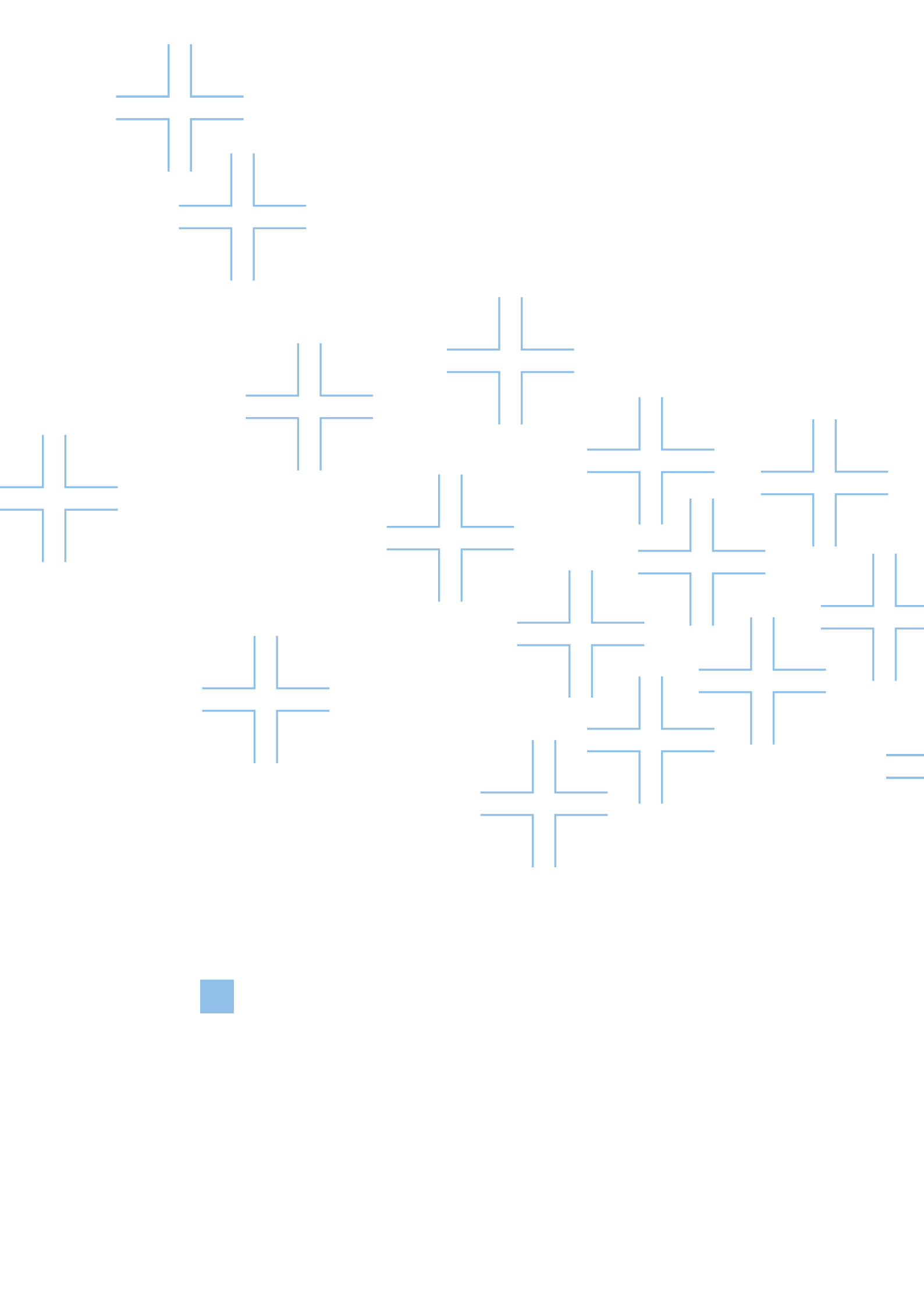
An Ambitious Hospital in the Caribbean

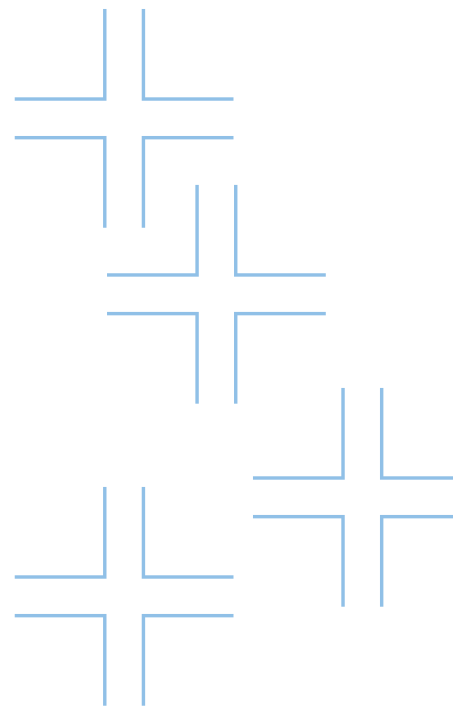
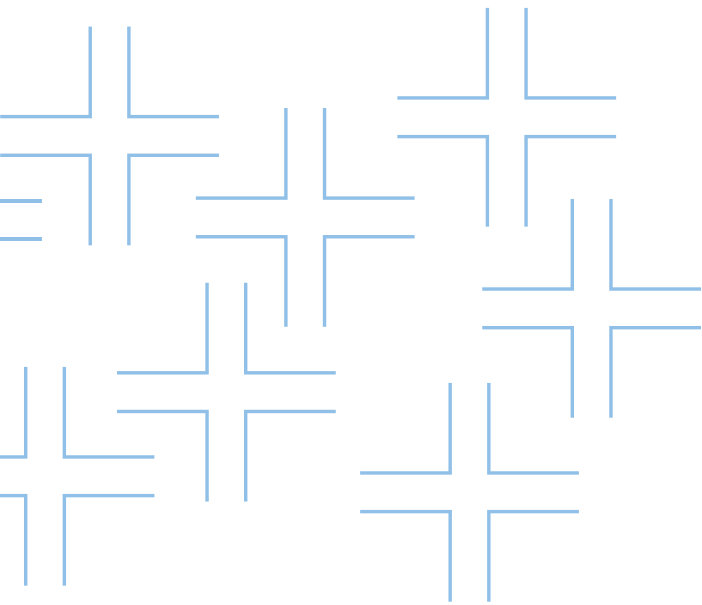
Our aim is to develop SMMC to a prominent medical institution in the Caribbean in order to deliver quality care close to home. The new St. Maarten General Hospital will be a state-of-the-art hospital, Category 5 hurricane resilient and means an expansion to the following:

- 15.387 m2 gross surface
- 110 In-patient beds, divided by:
 - 8 special care beds (ICU/CCU)
 - 48 medical surgical beds
 - 38 mother & child beds
 - 16 daycare positions
- 4 Operating theatres
- 4 Outpatient clusters
- Dialysis clinic with up to 30 positions
- Radiology department including MRI
- 2 General Practitioner clinics at the Emergency
- Helideck
- Pharmacy and Laboratory included
- Parking Garage / 420 Parking lots



The total employee base for the St. Maarten General Hospital will be approximately 400 FTE's.







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
