Our primary service area of St. Maarten, Statia and Saba, represents a total population of approximately 60.000 people, constituting a multi-cultural mix with more than 100 different nationalities. In addition, we also offer health care services to the two million visitors annually. SMMC has started the construction of the new St. Maarten General Hospital (SMGH) to expand its services in order to accommodate the increased care demand of the people of St. Maarten, its visitors and neighboring islands. The new hospital is planned to be operational in 2026.

Providing quality care is of utmost importance to you in addition to maintaining the continuity of care for our patients. You are enthusiastic and willing to actively contribute to the daily operations and the intended developments for the future of our organization.

## Requirements:

- Registered as a Doctor with a Doctor of Medicine (M.D.) degree;
- A specialty in Pulmonology;
- Patient-centered with a great bedside manner and a high level of flexibility;
- Ambitious and willing to ensure continuity and quality of care;
- Highly adaptable and able to work independently and with a team;
- Comfortable handling and managing multiple responsibilities;

## Tasks:

- Examines, diagnoses and treats patients, if necessary using information and data from other medical disciplines and in coordination and consultation with medical specialists and other care providers;
- Writes treatment plans and records relevant data;
- Coordinates multidisciplinary patient care;
- Prescribes and administers medication, provides information to patients and performs medical procedures;
- Performs rounds, assesses the health status and stability of the patient in relation to the treatment plan and adjusts the plan if necessary.
- Contributes to the development and execution of quality management by developing protocols and procedures in cooperation with other medical specialists.
