Requirements:

- A recognized midwifery degree;
- Valid medical qualifications (if Dutch-trained, BIG and KNOV registration is required);
- Ultrasound training is a plus;

- Fluency in English (Proficiency in Dutch, French and/or Spanish is a plus).

Tasks:

- Conduct prenatal examinations and monitor pregnancies, including CTG-surveillance;
- Assess patient needs and develop personalized care plans;

- Provide instruction and education on breastfeeding;
- Perform routine screening tests;
- Measure vital signs, including pulse, blood pressure, and temperature;
