You have a broad interest in all aspects of internal medicine and hematology and are a team player willing to work in a small team as you actively contribute to the daily operation of our hospital and (intended) developments for the future of our organization.

### What We Offer:

At SMMC, we offer you the opportunity to work in a dynamic, fast-paced environment with an enthusiastic team of qualified professionals. You'll embark on a full-time role within our expanding organization with many opportunities for personal and professional development.

### Requirements:

- Medical degree (MD or DO) from an accredited institution;
- Completion of a residency in Internal Medicine and a fellowship in Hematology;
- Registered as an Internist-Hematologist with a valid license to practice;
- Proficiency in diagnostic and therapeutic procedures related to hematology
- Excellent communication, interpersonal, and patient care skills;
- Working proficiency in English; knowledge of an additional language is a plus.

### Tasks:

- Examine, diagnose and treat patients with hematologic conditions such as anaemia, clotting disorders, leukemia, lymphoma and myeloma;
- Develop and implement individualized treatment plans based on patient needs and clinical guidelines;
- Prescribe and administer treatments such as chemotherapy, immunotherapy, and blood transfusions;
- Monitor and evaluate patient progress, adjusting treatment plans as necessary;
- Work in close collaboration with the SLS-lab to perform and interpret diagnostic tests such as blood smears, bone marrow biopsies, and gene tests;
- Utilize advanced imaging techniques and laboratory tests to diagnose and monitor hematologic diseases.
